Our school used to provide education at a different location between 2008-2018, when our address was 57 Binevler Street number 5, Şahinbey.

Starting from 2018 to 2019 educational year, our school has attained a new campus situated in the vicinity of Oncology Hospital. Our campus now covers an area of 10.453 m² and continues offering its service in the county of Şahinbey, Gaziantep under the name of Bahçeşehir Uğur Eğitim Kurumları.

FIRST MEETING

PROJECT INTRODUCTION AND FIRST TRAINING

The WISH Project introductory meeting was on 1st
November 2018 at Gaziantep University. Dr. Melike ÖZYURT,
Vice Dean at the Faculty of Education in Gaziantep University,
gave information about the project to the students involved. Also,
Prof.Dr. Mehmet Fatih ÖZMANTAR, Dean at the Faculty of
Education, also made a presentation on 21st century skills.







SECOND TRAINING

On 8th November 2018, Dr.Erhan TUNÇ and Dr.Zehra KESER ÖZMANTAR started on a second training which was later strengthened by a drama activity. Our drama teacher Dr.Bilge KUŞDEMİR KAYIRAN separated us in groups and asked us to perform a drama activity showing the hardships disabled people face in society. Thus, we were able to empathize with disabled people when facing their daily hardships. We then understood that all these hardships are not or shouldn't be a real obstacle for a successful life. In this way, we realized that it is possible to do something to help them and decided to raise awareness on this topic with the help of our project.







PROJECT INTRODUCTION AND FIRST TRAINING

Afterwards, we were told to make a tower using basic tools like spaghetti, marshmallow, a rope and tape. The highest standing tower was going to be the winner. This simple training taught us how to be solution oriented in a given short period and how to work as a team. This later on helped us be faster and solution oriented when writing the project. At the same time, this was an opportunity for us to socialize with student friends from IGAL and have fun among our intense school program.

PROJECT BASED LEARNING

On the next step of our project, a new meeting was held in the university cafeteria, aiming to create a more cordial and comfortable ambiance. There we created groups of six students, 3 of which were from Bahcesehir College and 3 from Istanbul Gaziantepliler Anatolian High school (IGAL) and following the instructions given to us there, we learned how to prepare a project in 8 steps.

As a result, we prepared solution based presentations and gave presentations in the presence of our teachers and the other groups of students.









OUR FIRST ACTIONS

After finishing our preparations, designing our posters and getting the presentation ready, we presented our work to the university teachers involved in the project. Together we determined the shortcomings of our work. We then started working on a second presentation filling in the missing parts and adding some more posters this time translating everything into English.

We had worked hard and thus we were very excited. With the feeling of responsibility overwhelming us, the problems the disabled people were facing were our own now. Our teachers liked our presentation and we started deliberations with associations concerned with the disabled.









FIRST PRACTICE

On 23rd November 2018, we had a visit from Gaziantep University teachers and we presented them our project, its aim and the phases we had been going through up to then. Depending on the area of interest of each of us, we have distributed duties and the decisions below were taken:

 The disability topic should be under debate as three different fields of social inclusion;


A poster competition should be held;

PREPARATION OF THE LOGO



First, we started investigating the problem. While doing so we found out that there were no disabled managers or employers in neither the news nor the internet industries. This situation led us to developing a problem solving a skill, which is much wanted in such project preparation as well as in daily life.

We then decided that there should also be a group of disabled 'white collar'-executives. That is how we got the idea to represent a physically disabled executive. We strongly believe that no disability-either physical or mental-should be an obstacle for anyone in his or her career. A prosthetic arm or leg might be able to do things that are not possible for a healthy arm or leg to do.



COMPLETION OF NECESSARY MEETINGS

We designated two organizations able to help us in our aim to give educational seminars to business people, possible employers for our target group. The first one was Mr. Yusuf Celebi, the Head of the Disabled people Department in Gaziantep Metropolitan Municipality. He was going to help us with gathering the business people in the city.

First, we went to Gaziantep Metropolitan Municipality and arranged a meeting with Mr. Yusuf Celebi. We described our project to him and he said he was proud of us. He promised to help us make the project happen and to support us with raising awareness on the topic.

The second organization to talk to was The Physically Disabled People Foundation. We wanted to have this foundation on our side because of Elif Yıldız, who is a psychologist specialized in disabilities. After presenting the project and the aims we try to achieve, she accepted to help us with a seminar presenting the psychology of disabled people to the business people with the purpose of raising awareness.









POSTER COMPETITION






POPULARIZING OUR WORK




