The Erasmus+ project Work for an Inclusive School Heritage is based on mutual co-operation among two universities and three high schools. The project is aimed at social inclusion awareness and progress in educational strategies referring to project-based learning and the development of the 21st-century skills:

2. Learning and Innovation Skills

3. Information and Technology Skills

- Creativity and Critical Thinking
- Communication and Collaboration



STUDENT EXCHANGES

The high school students are exchanged within one-week in Cuneo (IT), Manresa (ES) and Žilina (SK) during the whole project period. They develop their abilities to co-operate, to solve the problems and to use the on-line software technologies.



TRAINING EVENTS

Teachers of the individual high schools and academicians of partner universities cooperatively study on the topics and implement them practically in school environments enriched with theoretical backgrounds.
